Regarding REACH, Authorisation list and SVHC compliance for AkzoNobel Industrial Coatings' products.

Dear Madame and Sir,

Thanks for your request regarding AkzoNobel Industrial Coatings' products and compliance under the **REACH** regulation 1907/2006 (**R**egistration, **E**valuation, **A**uthorisation and **R**estriction of **C**hemicals).

The products that AkzoNobel Industrial Coatings supplies to you are considered as mixtures containing a number of substances. The mixtures themselves do not need to be registered under REACH. However, the substances in the mixtures have to be registered or are exempt from the registration obligation, e.g. polymers.

As AkzoNobel Industrial Coatings is mainly a downstream user under REACH we are dependent on that our raw material suppliers have registered the substances (>1 t) that we use in the manufacturing of our products.

We are pleased to confirm that to the best of our knowledge all the substances included in the products sold by Akzo Nobel Industrial Coatings are registered according, or exempted from, the REACH regulation.

Substances included on Annex XIV, Authorisation list of the REACH regulation no.1907/2006 are not included in our products.

Substances included on the Candidate list of the REACH regulation no.1907/2006 have been identified as Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC).

AkzoNobel Industrial Coatings herewith confirm that Substances of Very High Concern¹, will be present in section 15 in the Safety Data Sheet according to our obligations in Regulation (EC) No 1272/2008.

For other substances included, which are hazardous to health or environment, we kindly refer to the Safety Data Sheet section 3 of each product.
